

20 Outdoor Art in Nature Ideas for Kids

Here are 20 fun and creative outdoor art activities you can try with preschoolers:

- Nature collages with leaves, flowers, and pinecones.
- Rock painting with bright designs or story pictures.
- Leaf printing with paint on paper.
- Leaf rubbings with crayons and pastels.
- Stick sculptures tied together with yarn.
- Nature mandalas arranged in circular patterns.
- Mud painting on cardboard or old sheets.
